

## **INFORMATION ON LEI CODES FOR THE TRANSACTIONS WITH THE FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS**

In order to conclude deals with financial instruments, clients – legal entities need a **LEI code**.

**The LEI (Legal Entity Identifier)** is a unique 20 alphanumeric combination code, which is used to identify legal entities operating on the financial market.

In order to receive a **LEI code**, client have to choose one of the internationally **LEI** issuing organizations which have a right to issue **LEI codes** to legal entities.

If the client will not obtain a **LEI code**, then client will not be able to perform any transactions with the financial instruments on the account, incl. to submit orders for the purchase, sale or transfer of the financial instruments.
